Location. Permanently moored in Long Beach, California, adjunct to Queen Events Park, the Queen Mary outlived her sea-worthy days and now offers guests a unique portal into her historic past. We have a wonderful opportunity to stay on her this year.

Hotel Features. Art Deco ambience permeates the Queen Mary Hotel with brass-and-nickel fixtures and vaulted ceilings. The hotel features original art, and 1930s dinnerware and furniture. The Queen Mary Hotel features three harbor-view restaurants and an on-board spa that offers massages, facials, reflexology and chiropractic treatments
